Fyrsti búnaðarskóli á Íslandi (1880-1907) og einn merkasti staður í landbúnaðarsögu Íslands. Glæsilegt skólahús frá 1896. Stytta Ríkarðs Jónssonar af Torfa og Guðlaugu í Ólafsdal. Fallegar gönguleiðir. Merkar minjar um byggingar, vatnsveitu, hleðslur og ræktun. Fræðslustígur. Áhugaverðar sýningar um sögu Ólafsdalsskólans. Lífrænt vottað Ólafsdalsgrænmeti. Kaffi. lettar veitingar og Erpsstaðaís. Ólafsdalshátíð verður haldin 12. ágúst.

Ólafsdalur by Gilsfjörður; eco and slow travel site

Ólafsdalur is a small valley, surrounded by high mountains, where the first agricultural school in Iceland was established in 1880. The beautiful school-building from 1896 is open to the public. Exhibitions about the history of the school and art exhibiton. Educational trail and interesting walking paths. Remains of other buildings and man made remains from 1880-1900. Ólafsdalur organic vegetables for sale. Coffee, refreshments and local icecream. Ólafsdalur Festival will be held August 12th.
